

## Consequences for Not Meeting Pre-Rotation Requirements

**Date: 10/16/06**

**Consequence:** Change rotation grade

**Criteria:**

Student misses any established pre rotation deadline due date, for pre materials or documentation, by more than 2 days, but is completed before rotations begin, or the next rotation starts.

Student payment for drug screens and background check. The student either:

- 1) Does not pay at all or is more than 2 days late
- 2) Check is returned for insufficient funds

Student portfolio:

- 1) Does not have a copy of all necessary materials on arrival at the rotation.

- First Offense: Reduction in rotation grade by 5% e.g., 90% to 85.5%\*
- Second Offense: Reduction in rotation grade by 10%\*
- Third Offense: Reduction in rotation grade by 20%.\*

NOTE: If deadline violations occur before rotations begin e.g., March 2007 the standards are applied to the first scheduled rotation. Otherwise, they apply to the rotation the student is currently completing.

**Consequence: Removal from Rotation and Evaluation of Status in the College of Pharmacy**

**Criteria:**

- Drug Screen
  - Refusal to complete, positive or adulterated screen **or** delay in completing drug screen; with loss of more than 2 days of rotation time.
  - Refusal to complete the Drug Screen and/or Background Waiver form
  - Delay in completing; with loss of more than 2 days of rotation time.
- Background Screen
  - Refusal to complete or explain positive background findings.
  - Positive findings NOT declared on College application form.
  - Positive finds of a serious criminal conviction unknown to administration and Admissions Committee during the student's tenure in the College.

\* The SUCCESS grade will be reduced by the appropriate amount after it has been submitted by the preceptor.

Of course, allowances will be made for extraordinary circumstances.
