- ❖ The college currently has four campuses—Gainesville, Jacksonville, St. Petersburg and Orlando.
- ❖ In 2008, there were a total of 321 PharmD graduates for Gainesville, Jacksonville, St. Pete and Orlando combined.
- ❖ In 2008, approximately 1800 applications were received and 302 new pharmacy students were admitted for the class of 2012.
- ❖ The Working Professional PharmD (WPPD) program continues to expand its enrollment with approximately 555 current students and over 1200 graduates.
- ❖ 82 graduate students are working toward their PhD in Pharmacodynamics, Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Outcomes and Policy, Pharmacy Practice and Medicinal Chemistry.
