Refunds

Refunds are **issued after** the last date listed per amount and according to the schedule below for students following proper withdrawal procedures. If you received Federal Aid additional requirements/fees may apply.

Refund Amount	Withdrawal Date
If you withdraw on or before the following date, you will receive a full tuition refund minus a \$200 administrative fee.	Spring 09: 1/23/09 Summer 09: 5/15/09 Fall 09: 9/11/09
If you withdraw on or between the following dates, you will receive a 40% refund of tuition.	Spring 09: 1/24/09 – 2/20/09 Summer 09: 5/16/09 – 6/12/09 Fall 09: 9/12/09 – 10/16/09
If you withdraw on or after the following date, you will not receive a tuition refund.	Spring 09: 2/21/09 Summer 09: 6/13/09 Fall 09: 10/17/09
<i>Withdrawal on or after this date will result in a Failing Grade.</i>	Spring 09: 3/21/09 Summer 09: 7/11/09 Fall 09: 11/14/09
